Disatisfaction was expressed at the lack of information, the lack of time and pressure for the matter to be considered. The Council agreed that it should be requested that an engineer address the meeting on 5th February to answer questions relating to the options in order that there is a better understanding. Disappointment that the embankment option previously delivered as a possibility was not a real option due to the logistics of construction and achieving an outcome. It was agreed in principle that option 3, the reduced height solid wall with the addition of a half moon coping stone be approved subject to an engineer being available to attend the 5th February meeting. The wall should be constructed of Cambridge brick.
